The second meeting was hosted by Romania. The project participants from Turkey and Greece were hosted in presence, in the city of Braila and in the partner school, where they were able to meet the general school inspector of Braila, Prof. PhD Catalin Canciu, the school inspector for technical and vocational education of Braila Prof. Daniela Condei and the journalist Liliana Nistor for the local newspaper "Obiectiv".

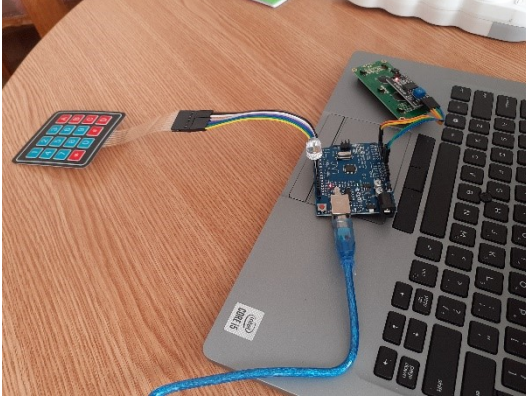
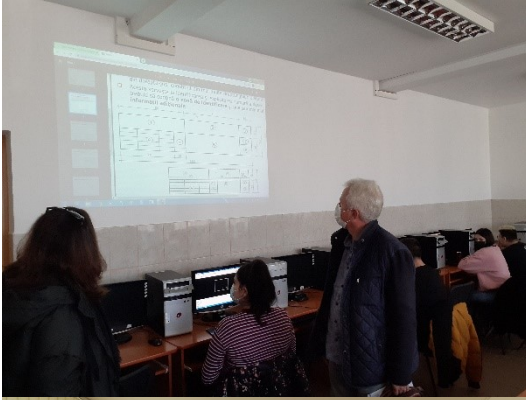
After having visited the classrooms and laboratories of the Institute, the participants gathered for the beginning of the real meeting, with the virtual addition of Italian and Austrian teams, connected through Google.Meet platform.

During the meeting, the Romanian school presented the project products, realized by their school. A video of the outcomes has been showed by the students. They presented modules of the Dot Matrix display and the KeyPad, with the technical info and the source codes of each one.

At the end of this moment of sharing, the participants verified the realization of the translations of the documents on the shared folder and agreed on the next steps. The dates of January 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>, have been chosen for the next meeting in Italy and May 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> for the meeting in Austria.

The Italian team will take care of editing the Newsletter and filling its form. Romania will prepare the certificates for the Italian and Austrian online participants and upload them on Google Drive. Furthermore, each partner will prepare video tutorials in English for their respective projects.

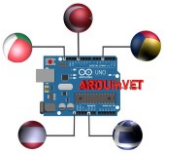
Finally, the online meeting was dissolved and the participants on site could continue their visit to the city of Braila.
